



Cat Food Recall

Nutro Products issues voluntary recall for limited range of dry cat food

Nutro Products announced on May 21, 2009 that they are a limited recall of NUTRO® NATURAL CHOICE® COMPLETE CARE® Dry Cat Foods and NUTRO® MAX® Cat Dry Foods with “Best If Used By Dates” between May 12, 2010 and August 22, 2010.

The recall is due to incorrect levels of zinc and potassium resulting from a production error by a US-based premix supplier. Both zinc and potassium are essential nutrients for cats and are additions to NUTRO® dry cat food. The recall does not affect any NUTRO® dog food products, wet dog or cat food, or dog and cat treats.

Consumers who have purchased affected product should immediately stop using the recalled food, and switch to another nutritionally complete cat food. As of May 22, there are no reported consumer complaints related to this issue.

If you have been feeding the recalled food, watch your cat carefully for weight loss, lowered appetite or refusal of food, vomiting or diarrhea. If your cat is experiencing health issues or is pregnant, please contact your veterinarian as soon as possible.
